Required documents:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Application form (after registration student has to download the application form, have it signed and upload it together with other required documents)</li> <li>• Transcript of Records of the recent studies</li> <li>• Language Certificate proving at least B1/B2 level of English</li> <li>• ONLINE Learning Agreement</li> <li>• Copy of the passport or national ID</li> </ul> <p>It is the student's responsibility to upload all required documents before the deadline. All documents must be in English.</p>
