Course content:	Geotourism as a form of tourism and the subject of scientific examples of official sources; databases and geotourism portals - workshop; geotourism potential, tourist attractions vs. geosites and geotourism product - a study trip to the Tuchola Landscape Park and the Krajeński Landscape Park in Kuyavian-Pomeranian Voivodeship in Poland, Earth's heritage (geoheritage) as an example of UNESCO World Cultural and Natural Heritage Sites; the idea of creating geoparks on the world - workshop; a study trip to the Geological Museum of the Polish Geological Institute - National Research Institute and/or national geopark in Poland, as an examples of a contemporary form of promoting sightseeing and geotourism in the world

K02 - the student understands the relationships between the abiotic and cultural environment (which is the result of human socio-economic activity) in space on the example of objects with geotouristic values (K_W02, K_W03).
